## **GUEST SPEAKER: Lisa Myers, Director, Manos del Uruguay**



Lisa knitted her first sweater when she was 14 years old as a hobby that lasted throughout her educational years. She graduated from the University of Pennsylvania with a Ph.D. For the next 20 years, Lisa pursued her hobby as a local yarn shop owner in Philadelphia, PA. At that time, Lisa had two daughters, published knitwear designs with yarn companies and national magazines, authored two knitting books, *The Joy of Knitting and The Joy of Knitting Companion*, and co-wrote a third book called *Knit So Fine*.

Since 2006 Lisa has been the Director of Fairmont Fibers, the sole US distributor of Manos del Uruguay yarns. Currently, Lisa lives in Philadelphia and travels the country to promote the hand-dyed, artisan Manos del Uruguay yarns. She leads exciting tours to Uruguay for

knitters to learn the hand-dyed yarn process, and she loves teaching her craft, marketing new colors, and participating in product development.

#### PRESENTATION: Two-Color Long-Tail Cast-on Method

Lisa will talk about the history of Manos del Uruguay and lead us through a virtual tour of the Uruguay countryside to view how the artisans create their unique blend of colors. She will also present the newest color spectrum, and there will be a trunk show. Yarns will be available to purchase at a 10% discount.

Lisa will teach us the simple technique of two-color long-tail cast-on. To learn, bring two colors of medium weight yarn and the appropriately sized needles.

Following the presentation, you can join our **KAL** led by Norine Grodin or the **Beginners Circle** led by Johanna Decourcy. You are also welcome to stay and knit during the remainder of our time together.



#### KAL: 405 LEX – designed by Anne Hanson
