GUEST SPEAKER: Norah Gaughan—Editor in Chief, *Vogue Knitting*



If you have been knitting for any period of time, you know the work of Norah Gaughan, new Editor in Chief of *Vogue Knitting*. Norah has spent her life immersed in knitting. She started her brilliant career freelancing for yarn companies and knitting magazines. Later, as a design director for JCA Crafts, she oversaw the yarn lines of Reynolds, Artful Yarns, and Adrienne Vittadini, while also working as design director at Berroco.

She is the author of *Norah Gaughan's Knitted Cable Sourcebook: A Breakthrough Guide to Knitting with Cables and Designing Your Own* (2016) and *Knitting Nature: 39 Designs Inspired by Nature* (2006). Her newest book, *Norah Gaughan's Twisted Stitch Sourcebook: A Breakthrough Guide to Knitting and Designing*, is due out in January 2021.
